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Medtronic 780G Special Authority Requirements (per telephone conversation with BC Pharmacare 2019-Nov-27)

Dear Pharmacare

Thank you for considering my patient for a Special Authority for the Medtronic MiniMed pump. Below are listed the 6 qualifying conditions. I understand to qualify for Special Authority my patient needs to meet only one of these six. See below pertinent conditions for this patient ticked and annotated as necessary.

- X**Daily insulin requirement of > 65 units (>200 over 3 days) - see attached supporting documentation of total daily dose
Total daily dose = 150 units
- Daily insulin requirement of <15 units per day (requiring basal insulin infusion rates <0.5 ml/hr)
- Teflon/infusion set allergy to Omnipod pod (see below description of the nature of reaction). It is understood that evidence of dispensation of Omnipod on Pharmanet is required for approval.
- History of hypoglycemia unawareness or severe hypoglycemia (*if coming from non-Endocrinologist office details are required*)
- Cognitive impairment; impaired level of consciousness - see patient specific details below
- Previously stable on Medtronic pump
